A new competition

The UEC Cyclo-cross European Cup is the premier Cyclo-cross racing series in Europe and are aiming of setting the standard for future development of Cyclo-cross in Europe. The UEC will propose this opportunity to the already existing C1 and C2 events.

The UEC Cyclo-cross European Cup will be contested over a maximum number of 12 events and one final race.

Who can participate?

The UEC Cyclo-cross European Cup events shall be open to the following age categories:

MEN / WOMEN U17 MEN / WOMEN U19 MEN / WOMEN U23

MEN MASTER

9 possible age categories

WOMEN MASTER

6 possible age categories


The UEC Cyclo-cross European Cup events shall be open to the following teams:

CLUBS

REGIONAL TEAMS

NATIONAL TEAMS

Max. 5 riders per team (except for riders of the organizer's nationality of the given round and all Master categories, for which the number of riders is not limited)





Race program of the event

All rounds of UEC Cyclo-cross European Cup shall be organized in two days with the competition covering the following categories:

First day

Women / Men MASTER

Second day

Women / Men U17 + U19 + U23

Each organizer can include in the schedule other national categories according to the time possibilities, such as the beginners' races, etc..





Candidatures for the UEC Cyclo-cross European Cup

The following week-ends are available for the organization of a round of the UEC Cyclo-cross European Cup, with a rights fee of 2500 €

The candidatures with an indication of the places and dates of the competitions must be submitted to UEC Management Board no later than 30 June 2021

Specific rules and regulations

Rules

The races of UEC Cyclo-cross European Cup are run under rules, conditions and instructions of UEC.

Races of categories entered in the UCI calendar must fully respect the UCI rules.

Races of categories entered in the national calendar must fully respect the rules of the relevant national cycling federation.

Start numbers and resultats services

Each organizer of UEC Cyclo-cross European Cup event have to provide start numbers and an appropriate result service.

The electronic device provided by the timing service provider shall be identical for all riders participating in the same race. It shall be considered as an identification number, similar to the start numbers (1 body number and 2 shoulder numbers).

The results of races of all categories must be sent electronically to the UEC after the end of the race. Moreover, the results of races entered in the UCI calendar must be transmitted also to the UCI via the UCI DataRide.

Anti-doping control

Anti-doping will be carried out according to UCI or National rules as appropriate.

Prizes

All prizemoney for individual events to be paid directly from the organiser to the rider.

The scale of prizes for the final individual classification of the UEC Cyclo-cross European Cup will be determined by UEC Management Board.
